Program Features

- 90 to 120 minutes Online-Zoom-sessions which are recorded for asynchronous review at any time.
- International Professors from different countries and specialisations will be conducting the live sessions.
- All Students will be taught 12 critical Global skills.
- According to the level of individual competence, everybody will have a customized learning journey, with an assessment, learning materials, videos, interaction with others and working on a case studies.



Each week IB Students will need to spend time in the learning platform – around 5 to 8 hours – and will need to read some ofteaching materials provided in the program to prepare for the class. Upon completion of the required coursework, which is due not later than two weeks after the course ends the GMN will provide a Certificate. In total there is a workload of up to 120 hours including extra written reports.
