

Conditions of participation in the CIMA & UEW Program, academic year 2022/2023

1. Joint program implemented by AICPA & CIMA and Wrocław University of Economics and Business, hereinafter: "CIMA & UEW Program")
2. CIMA & UEW Program is intended for students majoring in:
 - 2.1. Accounting and Controlling;
 - 2.2. Postgraduate studies – Business Accounting– Operational level (Dip MA)
 - 2.3. Postgraduate studies – Management Accounting – Management level (Adv Dip MA)
3. The CIMA & UEW Program covers the following levels of the CGMA Professional Qualification and offers the students an opportunity to obtain a respective CIMA designation:
 - 3.1. Certificate level: Certificate in Business Accounting (CIMA Cert BA);
 - 3.2. Operational level: Diploma in Management Accounting (CIMA Dip MA);
 - 3.3. Management level: Advanced Diploma in Management Accounting (CIMA Adv Dip MA).
4. CIMA Program students complete the Program based on their University's curriculum and 2019 CIMA Professional Qualification Syllabus.
5. The CIMA & UEW Program requires completion of the following set of subjects (taught in Polish or in English):

6. In order to complete the CIMA & UEW Program and obtain a certificate/diploma of the CGMA Professional Qualification, students are obliged to:
 - 6.1. read CIMA Program's policy and accept its provisions;
 - 6.2. register for the CIMA & UEW Program;

- 6.2.1. between the 3rd and 5th semester of the first-cycle studies for the Certificate of Business Accounting (Cert BA) and Operational level;
- 6.2.2. on the 1st semester of the second-cycle studies for the Management level;
- 6.2.3. up to 2 months from the date of commencement of postgraduate studies;
- 6.3. Complete the educational Program (University syllabus) and required courses pursuant to point 5.
- 6.4. Pass a standardized CIMA external exam in English before the date of defence of their diploma's thesis or final exam at the University;
- 6.5. Pay any fees related to their participation in the CIMA Program and external exam.
7. CIMA and the University reserve the right to remove the students from a CIMA Program roster if the candidate fails to take CIMA exam(s) (held at the University and/or externally) and/or fails to pay applicable fees.
8. Students who meet all requirements indicated above and complete the CIMA & UEW Program will be sent a certificate after 12 weeks from receiving the 'pass' result of their final exam at each level.
