

R-B-SOP.021.1.77.2021 **REGULATION NO. 184/2021 Rector of the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business** of 22 December 2021 **on teaching classes at the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business**

Pursuant to Article 23(2)(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) in connection with the Act of 2 March 2020 concerning specific solutions related to preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19, other infectious diseases and crisis situations caused by them (consolidated text Journal of Laws of the Laws of 2020, item 1842, as amended), it is ordered as follows.

§ 1

- 1. Subject to section 2 of this Regulation, until 9 January 2022, all classes that form parts of the Bachelor's and Master's degree programs and at the Doctoral School at the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business shall be conducted in a remote form.
- 2. Classes (excluding lectures and seminars) that form parts of full-time and part-time first degree programs in Management and Production Engineering shall be held at the University's premises.
- 3. The decision concerning the form of the classes to be conducted within the period referred to in section 1 as a part of the Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA) program shall be taken by the Director of the EMBA program.
- 4. The decision concerning the form of the classes to be conducted within the period referred to in section 1 at the Economic Children's University, Young Economist's Academy and the University of the Third Age (also applies to the Boleslawiec campus) shall be taken by the appropriate Plenipotentiary of the Rector.
- 5. The decision concerning the form of classes to be conducted within the period referred to in section 1, as a part of a particular postgraduate program, shall be taken by the head of the postgraduate program, who shall inform the Director of the Centre for Lifelong Learning of his or her decision.
- 6. Diploma thesis defenses conducted within the time limit referred to in section 1 shall be held remotely.
- 7. Consultations concerning the date referred to in section 1 shall be held remotely in accordance with the rules set out in Regulation No. 22/2017 of the Rector of the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business.
- 8. Up to 25% of each course taught remotely is permitted to be held asynchronously using the Moodle Platform, while at least 75% should be held synchronously using the Teams module of Office 365.



§ 2

As of 23 December 2021, the following regulations of the Rector of the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business shall be repealed:

- 1. Regulation No. 151/2021 of 15 November 2021 on teaching classes at the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business,
- 2. Regulation No. 160/2021 of 2 December 2021 on teaching classes at the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business.

§ 3

This Regulation shall enter into force as of 23 December 2021.
