REGULATION NO. 219/2020

of the Rector of the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business

of December 10, 2020

on participation in classes organized by the University not included in the curriculum, for which a student may obtain no more than 30 ECTS credits

§ 1

Pursuant to § 8 Section 1(3) of the University Academic Regulations, the student, with the consent of the Dean for Student Affairs / Dean of the Branch, has the right to participate in classes organized by the University which are not covered by the curriculum of the field of study. The student cannot obtain more than 30 ECTS credits for participation in such classes.

§ 2

- 1. The prerequisite for obtaining the consent of the Dean for Student Affairs / Dean of the Branch to participate in the classes organized by the University, not covered by the curriculum of the field of study, is to complete the previous semester (this does not apply to first semester students).
- 2. The classes referred to in § 1 may only include subjects offered within the same form and degree of study and do not apply to EMBA subjects.
- 3. The application for consent to participate in the classes should be submitted no later than 2 weeks before the beginning of the semester in which the selected subjects occur.
- 4. The student is responsible for checking whether the deadlines for completing the subjects do not interfere with the timetable of the core curriculum.
- 5. After receiving consent to pursue a subject not covered by the curriculum, the subject becomes compulsory for the student and is listed in the diploma supplement. However, the grade for this subject is not included in the average grade, and ECTS credits are not included in the completion of the semester in which the subject occurs.
- 6. Resignation from additional subjects, in the form of a written declaration addressed to the Dean for Student Affairs / Dean of the Branch is possible no later than before the date of the second class.
- 7. A student who resigns from participation in a subject without submitting the resignation, as specified in section 6, will receive an unsatisfactory grade in the USOS system.
- 8. If a student does not pass the subjects for which he/she has received consent referred to in section 5, it is concluded that the student has not fulfilled the requirements set forth in the University Academic Regulations for the completion of a semester.
- 9. In the situation referred to in section 8, the student shall be required to repeat the subject pursuant to the rules set forth in § 21 of the University Academic Regulations.
- 10. Classes not included in the curriculum, referred to in this regulation, are carried out free of charge, but the repetition is subject to a fee, in accordance with the relevant regulation of the Rector on fees for educational services.
