

REGULATIONS FOR EARNING CREDIT FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES

Legal basis: University Regulations for Students
(Uczelniany Regulamin Studiów – URS)
Wrocław 2016 r.

- I. The student, in order to earn credit for Physical Education classes, shall satisfy the following conditions:
 1. Systematically attend Physical Education classes with the group to which he/she registered in compliance with the principles indicated in section II.
 2. Attend physical fitness and endurance tests, if any.
 3. Make up for absences by the end of the semester.
 4. The persons who have not attended the classes to which they registered and from which they failed to resign within three days after the electronic registration closed, shall not earn credit for the subject.
 5. Credit for Physical Education classes may be earned only within the primary deadline /§ 15 par. 3 of URS/.

- II. The following rules of class attendance are agreed on:
 1. Credit for Physical Education classes may be earned during /§ 4, par. 2 of URS/:
 - a) undergraduate studies – initial four semesters
 - b) graduate studies – initial two semesters
 2. The maximum number of 5 absences per semester, not more than 3 of which are allowed to remain not made up for, shall be permitted. Absences shall be made up for pursuant to section II item 3 hereof and excuse notes shall be submitted pursuant to § 10, par. 1, subpar. 9 of URS.
 3. Absences shall be made up for in compliance with the following rules:
 - a) the student may attend only one Physical Education class during one day,
 - b) the student may attend three Physical Education classes, i.e. one obligatory class and two additional classes, during one week,
 - c) absences shall be made up for on an ongoing basis.

- III. Rules for being excused from classes on other grounds.
 1. Excuse notes for the whole semester for health reasons may be acknowledged based on a medical certificate.
 2. If the student, during the semester in which he/she registered to Physical Education classes, receives a medical certificate which does not permit him/her to attend at least 12 classes during the semester, he/she shall be treated as a student who has not registered for Physical Education classes.
 3. The Physical Education and Sports Department Head shall give credit to the students who are members of the national, Olympic, Universiade team or sports section by the Students' Sport Association of the University of Economics (AZS UE).
 4. The Physical Education and Sports Department Head may give credit to the students who are members of sports sections which are not affiliated to AZS UE.



5. The Physical Education and Sports Department Head may excuse students from classes:
 - a) when students raise children under or at the age of 1 upon confirmation thereof,
 - b) in other special cases.
 6. Any and all requests and excuse notes related to item 1 shall be delivered to the Secretary's Office of the Physical Education and Sports Department by the end of the third week counting from the beginning of each semester and in the case of item 2 – within a week from the moment when the student's health condition permits that. Medical certificates or other documents delivered after the time-limit shall not be acknowledged.
- IV.** Requests for being excused for other reasons and appeals from the decision of the Physical Education and Sports Department Head as regards excuse notes shall be considered by the Dean.
