



Competency goals for the teachers

- Assignment Module to collect work and provide feedback

• Then you could practice teaching at itslearning

Roles within the Project

Sponsor Executive

Set the pedagogical vision and strategy of the organization and communicate that to the project group.

Participate in establishment, ongoing status and conclusion of pilot.

Configure the site: privacy, security, user rights and access.

Administrato

1st line support for teachers and students.

Upload student and teacher information to provision

System accounts, send passwords, etc.

Provide information about the S Communication project, timeline and groups within the university community.

Share successes.

Build courses and study Teachers modules inside itslearning.

Engage with students by sharing information, communicating, providing feedback and using digital teaching tools.

Utilise digital teaching with tools such as peer assessment, formative testing, discussion forums, group messaging.


